

2008 DRIVER'S ED ONLINE CONTEST

OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES:

No purchase necessary to enter. Void where prohibited by law. This contest is open to Girl Scout members only between the ages of 14-17, who submit parental authorization via the contest entry and release form completed by a parent or guardian who is aged eighteen years or older. No minors are eligible to enter and receive a prize unless, as set forth below, such release form is submitted on behalf of the minor, and Girl Scouts of the USA reserves the right to refuse to award a prize to or on behalf of a minor.

Employees of Girl Scouts of the USA, local Girl Scout council affiliates and staff, subsidiaries, and successor companies, board of directors, contest sponsors, advertising and promotion agencies, contest prize suppliers, participating advertisers and immediate family members of any one so situated are ineligible to participate on behalf of their daughter/charge. "Immediate family members" shall include spouses, siblings, parents, children, grandparents, and grandchildren, whether as "in-laws", or by current or past marriage, remarriage, adoption, co-habitation or other familial extension, and any other persons residing at the same household location, whether or not related.

HOW TO ENTER:

Contest entries must include a parent and/or guardian's name, complete mailing address, email address, adult's telephone number and girl entrant council's name. The official *ON THE ROAD DRIVER'S ED CONTEST* period is March 14, 2008 through April 3, 2008.

Girl Scout members between the ages of 14-17 years old who complete the *On The Road Driver's Ed* essay question and parental/guardian contest entry and release form will be entered into the *ON THE ROAD DRIVER'S ED CONTEST*. The grand-prize winner and all contest finalists will be notified that they have been awarded prizes from the respective contest prize levels by Girl Scouts of the USA by **April 18, 2008**

PRIZES:

CONTEST GRAND-PRIZE WINNER

One (1) grand-prize winner will be awarded an **Indianapolis 500** trip in 2008 sponsored by Firestone Complete Auto Care. The **Indianapolis 500** race is held on May 25th.
